## Aims and Guidelines

Walcha Farmers Market is a food, health, wellbeing and gardening market incorporating a limited number of makers and creators. The aim of the market is to provide a venue for consumers to learn about food by talking directly to producers, and to provide a platform for small businesses and backyard producers to sell their products. This will assist consumers in making informed decisions on food choices and better understand the paddock to plate process.

We also provide a platform for a limited number of makers and creators. Therefore our guidelines include

Anything edible, that is home-grown or homemade. Plants and homemade gardening items.

A limited number of makers and creators.

The majority of items sold on each stall need to be made or grown by the stallholder.

Stalls relating to health & wellbeing will also be accepted at the discretion of the committee. We do not accepts onsellers or re-sellers.

We do understand there is a grey area, so items will be included that complement the overall aim of the markets.
